CREATE A PRAISE TREE

What you'll need:

- Small branches
- Vase or small jar
- Construction paper (green and other assorted colors)
- Scissors
- Hole punch
- Ribbon or string
- Markers
- Box or basket



Instructions:

- 1. Collect some small branches that have fallen in your yard or a nearby park.
- 2. Arrange the branches in a vase or small jar. The branches will form the limbs of your praise tree.
- 3. Cut leaf shapes from the green construction paper. Cut flower shapes from paper of other colors. Punch a hole in each shape
- 4. Cut the ribbon or string into 4- to 5-inch pieces. Lace one piece through each hole.
- 5. Give each family member one green leaf and a marker. Ask each person to write on the leaf a praise statement, such as "I love you, Jesus!" or "God is great!"
- 6. Then invite each family member to write on a flower shape a blessing or something for which they would like to thank God.
- 7. Tie the leaves and flowers onto the branches of your praise tree.
- 8. Place a box or basket under the "tree." Put the remaining leaf and flower shapes into the container along with the ribbon and markers.
- 9. Continue adding your thanks and praises each Sunday of Lent until your branches are full.
